(E-5) Corner Common to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T45 N., R.1 E,

This corner is being re-established as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found iron pipe next to old concrete monument and remains of original B.T. stump to Northwest. Corner now falls in manmade fish rearing pond and is under water for about six months each year. Pond is drained every fall for removal of fish. The pond is quite large and nearby witnesses are not available.

Original corner post was placed in September, 1845 by James H. Mullett with 20" Cedar B.T. N32°W 35 links (23.1 feet). County Surveyor "Corner Ties" book indicates "large Cedar post 6" butt, large end up" and a cement monument with a 12" W. Birch B.T. S75°E 23 feet. In September, 1990 Ronald Bischer, P.S. 22428, found concrete monument, 1" iron pipe (placed by landowner), and recovered an original
