A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner Common to Sections 15, 16, 21, & 22, T45N, R1W.

Hemlock 12, N30°W 12 links Original ties to post: Spruce 12, S28°E 20 links

1958 - As recorded in liber 3, page 29, Chippewa County corner records by Billy Buckler, RLS 8887. Set 1" pipe w/brass cap. Witnesses: 10" Tamarack, S35°E 82½ links

12" White Birch, S33°W 32 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(T45N, R1W)

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found a ½" solid iron rod approximately 50 feet south of an east-west path. Also found blazed 15" tamarack and blazed 16" white birch bearing trees as called for in liber 3, page 29. Corner was established in 1958 by Billy Buckler, using section corner 1 mile south, 1/4 corner $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles east, and County Surveyor ties to old Mackinac Trail to the west. It appears corner was to have been monumented with a 1" pipe and Department of Conservation cap, but that did not happen. Accepted corner position as found and replaced $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron with a 3/4" rebar and aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(T45N, R1W)

Corner is a 3/4" x 24" rebar with 31 aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap 50 feet south of an east-west trail. Witnesses:

15" Tamarack, S35°E 55.10' 16" White Birch, S33°W 20.35'

8" Tamarack, EAST 18.37' 6" Spruce, N14°E 22.81'

Note: painted.

Distances are to a nail and tag in the side of the tree. Trees are blazed and Bearings are compass bearings AT III.S. THE REAL CO.
