Found no evidence of original corner. Found a 1/2" iron in concrete on extension of fenceline to the South. Road has been raised. Set a 1/2" iron with cap No. 27450 over the exisiting monument. Accepted corner position as found. Corner falls 23.10' East (GLO-23.10') of the re-established S.C. 34/35.
