This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County

Remonumentation Program.

Found a 1" pipe with 4" aluminum DNR cap on the north edge of a 2-track road to the west at the intersection of a 2-track road to the south, both bearing trees are gone. Buckler's corner form indicates that east-west position was established using a fence line to the north, north-south position established using road to the west. Found remains of the fence line to the north, east-west position also works well with Section corner to the west. I believe that the north-south position of this corner is somewhat questionable. However, other corners have been established and surveys have been done using this position, and having nothing to prove otherwise, I am accepting as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is 1" diameter pipe with 4" aluminum DNR cap on the north edge of a 2track road to the west at intersection of a 2-track road to the south. Witnesses:
