5. Private Claims

I, Keith R. Waters, in a field survey on April 11, 1997, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - C-10 1/4 Corner common to Sections 29 & 30, Town 45 North, Range 2 West
 - 1849 Original corner (spruce post) was established by Harvey Mellen, D.S. Witnesses: Spruce 8, N46°E 36 links White Pine 16, N19°W 16 links
 - 1921 County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown notes for Section 30 indicate a large stone set from an original bearing tree. The only other information shown is a note saying "8 rods long by computation" on the north 1/2 mile between Sections 29 and 30.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found a 1/2" rebar in the approximate centerline of north-south asphalt road (Tilson Road), on the extension of a fence line to the west. Rebar is 2618.81 feet from the section corner to the north, 2617.66 feet from the section corner to the south, and is 10.2 feet east of a straight line between said section corners. Accepted corner as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found a 1/2" rebar at the corner location, which falls in the approxiamate centerline of Tilson Road, on the extension of a fence line to the west.
