I, Keith R. Waters, in a field survey on August 19, 1997, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration;

K-10 1/4 Corner common to Sections 25 & 26, Town 45 North, Range 2 West

1849 - Original corner (tamarack post) was established by Harvey Mellen, D.S.

Witnesses: Tamarack 8, N59°E 32 links Tamarack 6, S80°W 38 links

1974 - LCRC liber 1, page 129, Lawrence R. Feindt, RLS 21566. Found railroad spike.

Witnesses: 12" Poplar, S20°W 95.80' - 8" White Pine, S20°E 91.10' - 11" Tamarack, N10°E 124.80

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found a railroad spike 0.5 feet east of the centerline of north-south asphalt road (Kinross Lake Road) and the Poplar and White Pine bearing trees as called for in above mentioned LCRC. Railroad spike is 2626.8 feet from section corner to the north, 2615.4 from section corner south, and is 1.4 feet east of a straight line between said section corners. I have been unable to determine the origin of this position. It has been used for numerous surveys in both Sections 25 and 26 for at least 23 years, and I am accepting the position as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a 3/4" x 24" rebar with a plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at corner location, replacing a found railroad spike. Corner is 0.5 feet east of the centerline of Kinross Lake Road. Witnesses:

Nail/tag #33142 in the side of 14" White Pine (blazed), S20°E 91.32' Nail/tag #33142 in the side of 12" White Pine (blazed), S86°E 17.04' Nail/tag #33142 in the side of 11" Tamarack, (blazed), N80°E 39.76' Nail/tag in face blaze in 14" Aspen, S22°W 95.91' 2" i.d. Iron Pipe, S88°E 32.97'

Note: Bearings are compass bearings corrected for declination.
