B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C-11) Section Corner Common to Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32, T.46 N., R.2 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

ON THE SHAME Found no evidence of the original corner. Found a 1" I.D. galvanized pipe and (4) witnesses as established by Wiggins; (1) witness was dead. Top of pipe had been destroyed by a grader. Accepted corner as found and reset a 3/4" x 24" iron at pipe location and established (1) new witness.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
