

1924 County Surveyor corner tie book notes large monument and a large number of unidentifiable witnesses.

1992 B. Feldhauser, P.S. 10685 surveyed the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, Section 36.

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B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K-11) Section Corner Common to Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, T.46 N., R.2 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner. Found a 3/4" O.D. pipe. Distance North is 5280.44' (C.S. 5282'); distance East is 5284.15' (C.S. 5282'); distance South is 5282.52' (C.S. is 5282'); distance West is 2639.95' (C.S. is 2643'). Accepted corner position as found and established (2) new witnesses.
