

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

.-11) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 25 and 36, T.46 N., R.2 W.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

OVUMEN COUMEN TO STATE AND STATE Found no evidence of the original corner. Found a 1/2" iron believed to have been set by Feldhauser. Found iron was 2.21 East and 1.87 South of position as noted on survey. Located several other corners from 1992 survey and they were all in their correctly stated positions. Reset corner by single proportionate measurement (mid-way and on line between adjacent Section corners). This position matches the Feldhauser survey. Distance East and West is 2642.07'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(L-11) 1/4 Comer Common to Sections 25 and 36, T.46 N., R.2 W.
