Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found a "T" iron next to a square wood post, with three blazed trees facing the found corner. Accepted found "T" iron as best available evidence of the corner location. Replaced the "T" iron with a 1/2" x 24" rebar and a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced a found "T" iron with a 3/2" x 24" rebar and a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, next to a found square wood post. Corner falls approximately 100 feet north of the old Soo Line Railroad Grade.
