

5. Private Claims

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1840 - Original corner established by Austin Burt. Witnesses: Spruce 6, N44°E 38 links - Cedar 10, N57°W 40 links.

1963 - Billy D. Buckler, R.L.S. 8887, Michigan Department of Conservation, Forestry Division, Land Corner Record, as recorded in Liber 3, Page 99, Chippewa County Corner Records. Found no evidence of original corner. Reestablished corner midway and on line between section corners. Set a 1" pipe with 4" aluminum cap. Witnesses:

8" Cedar (1/4S NBT), N44°W 46 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

DVOMEN This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found a 1" pipe with a stamped aluminum Department of Conservation cap and both bearing trees as called for in the above mentioned 1963 records. Measurements to adjacent corners confirm the method used in reestablishing the corner. Accepted the corner as found and established additional bearing trees.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found a 1" pipe with a stamped aluminum Department of Conservation cap at the corner location.

Nail and tag #33142 in 10" blazed Cedar, S45°W 35.66' (existing bearing tree)

Nail and tag #33142 in 8" blazed Cedar, N44°W 30.06' (existing bearing tree)
