

5. Private Claims

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

I-9 Corner Common to Sections 22, 23, 26, & 27, T46N, R7W

1850 - Original corner established by Wells Burt, a cedar post. Witnesses: Tamarack 10, S15°W 29 links - Tamarack 12, N21°E 21 links

Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Showing This corner is being reestablished as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of the original cedar post. Reestablished corner at the intersection of lines from found blazes in a large cedar and a tamarack. The distance to the 1/4 corner I-10 to the south is within 1 foot of the original GLO distance. The east-west position is within 5 feet of a pro-rated GLO distance between the 1/2 corner at H-9, 1/2 mile to the west and the section corner at M-9 on the range line, 2 miles to the east.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:


Placed a 1/2" x 24" rebar with a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at the corner location. Witnesses:
