

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found an iron pipe with a stamped aluminum Department of Natural Resources cap and all record bearing trees as called for in the above mentioned 1990 LCRC. The stump of the original white pine bearing tree S26°W 22 links is also still standing.
