

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(D-11) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 29 and 32, T. 46 N., R. 1 E.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner or of subsequent restoration. Reestablished corner equal distant between the section corners to the East and West and 30' South of an East-West fence. This position falls in the centerline or an East-West road and on the range of 1/4 line fences to the North and South. The position for the 1/4 corner falls 7.83' North of a line between the section corners and the distances East and West measure 2609.46'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(D-11) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 29 and 32, T, 46 N., R. 1 E.

Corner is a 1/2" x 24" re-bar with plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation Corner cap. The corner falls in the centerline of 11 mile rd. and on the extension of 1/4 line fences to the North and South.
