A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(I-8) & Corner Common to Sections 22 & 23, T46N-R1E The following is taken from County Surveyor notes by Fred Brown, circa 1910 -

"The line was in dispute between Montgomery and McDonald as to the E & W $_4$ line on the S side of E $_4$ NE $_4$ owned by Montgomery and the N side of SE $_4$ owned by McDonald. The line being short on the E side (5018 ft.) Montgomery took his 160 rds from the N and made fence and McDonald allowed it to remain after cutting it down several times. I believe the NE cor SE cor and SW cor to be all of the U.S. survey and have used them and made the survey of this section in the regular way and I think the owners are all satisfied except Montgomery."

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

The distance from the Southeast corner of Section 22 to the existing, disputed & line fence agrees reasonably well with County Surveyor distance (2509' record, 2510.08' measured). Re-established corner position on line between Northeast and Southeast measured). Re-established corner position on line between Nortneast and southern corners of Section 22 and 131' North of the disputed fence line in accordance with County Surveyor notes. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner. (I-8) Corner is a 3/4" x 24" iron with plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation cap, 0.8' West of the centerline of Riverside Drive.
