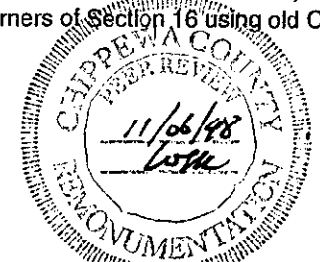

I, Larry R. Rogers in a field survey on November 06, 1998, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
(G-7) Northeast Corner of Section 21, Township 46 North, Range 2 East.
The original corner was placed in 1845 by James H. Mullett. County Surveyor records make no specific reference to Corner. In 1982, William L. Karr, P.S. 27450 found no evidence of original and "re-established corner position from NE & SW Corners of Section 16 using old County Surveyor notes". Karr filed a L.C.R.C. in Liber 6, Page 358 of the Chippewa County Corner Records.



B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
(G-7) Northeast Corner of Section 21, Township 46 North, Range 2 East.
This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found 1" drill rod set by Karr and recovered two witnesses. Corner falls 6 feet Southwesterly of the Southwesterly edge of Homestead Road (asphalt) and on the extension of the centerline of a 2-track road to West. Brush lines to North and South. Accepted corner position as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
(G-7) Northeast Corner of Section 21, Township 46 North, Range 2 East.
Corner is a 1" drill rod 6 feet Southwesterly of edge of asphalt of Homestead Road.
