

Karr, in a field survey on December 15, 1999, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - (C-4) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 7 and 8, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

James H. Mullett set post in original survey.

- F.H. Brown surveyed Plat of Washburn's Subdivision, 1/4 corner is the Southeast corner of the plat and falls in 1887 the intersecting centerlines of Superior St. and Eighth Ave.
- F. H. Brown surveyed Plat of Cody's Subdivision, 1/4 corner is the Northeast corner of the plat and falls in the 1887 intersecting centerlines of Superior St. and Eighth Ave.
- F.H. Brown and D.F. Henry surveyed Plat of Wilson's Addition. The plat shows the 1/4 corner on the East side in the intersecting centerlines of Superior St. and Eighth Ave.
- F.H. Brown surveyed Re-Plat of Washburn's Subdivision, 1/4 corner same as above.
- F.H. Brown surveyed Re-Plat of Cody's Subdivision, 1/4 corner same as above.
- Early 1900's Numerous sketches and notes in the County Surveyors Office show corner and give distances consistent with those shown on the plats.
- James H. Granger, P.S. 16041, re-established and recorded the corner in L. 1, P. 197, Chippewa County Corner Records. Granger re-established the position from adjacent subdivision corners.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C-4) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 7 and 8, T. 47 N., R. 1 E. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the corner set by Granger in 1976, due to road reconstruction. Subsequent to the platting of the surrounding area in the late 1800's and early 1900's, available records indicate there was no perpetuation of the corner position until Granger re-established it in 1976. Accepted Granger's method and re-established the corner from existing plat monumentation in the approximate intersecting centerlines of Superior St. and East Eighth Ave.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
 - (C-4) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 7 and 8, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

The corner is a 3/4" x 24" iron with a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation Cap set in a monument box in the intersecting centerlines of Superior St. and East Eighth Ave.
