

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E-4) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 8 and 9, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

James H. Mullett set post in original survey. 1845

Guy H. Carleton surveyed A.B. Wilgus Addition. Carleton shows the 1/4 corner as the Northeast corner of the 1887

F.H. Brown surveyed E.G. Endress Subdivision. Brown shows the 1/4 corner to be the Southwest corner of the 1901 subdivision and monumented with a 3/4" x 30" iron bolt.

1902 F.H. Brown surveyed Plat of Martyn and Stuart's Addition. Brown shows the 1/4 corner to be the Northwest corner of the plat and monumented with a 5/8" x 30" iron boit.

Early 1900's An undated sketch of section 8 in the County Surveyors Office shows the distance from the 1/4 corner South to the section corner as 2633.4'.

William L. Karr, P.S. 27450, recorded corner in L. 6, P. 369, Chippewa County Corner Records Recovered a 3/4" iron in Shunk Road whose position worked well with corners in A.B. Wilgus Addition.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E-4) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 8 and 9, T. 47 N., R. 1 E. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner. Recovered the 3/4" iron as recorded in 1986, the distance to the section corner to the South measures 2623.31'. Accepted the 3/4" iron for the corner and set an aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap on the iron and placed a monument box around the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(E-4) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 8 and 9, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

The corner is a 3/4" iron with a stamped Chippewa County Remonumentation Cap in a monument box. The corner falls 1.5' West of the centerline Shunk Road and on the centerline 8th Ave. to the East.
