

1, William L. Karr, in a field survey on December 13, 1999, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1/4 Corner between Sections 16 and 17, Township 47 North, Range 1 East.

1845 James H. Mullett set post in original survey.

Early 1900's The section survey by F.H. Brown (County Surveyor's Record Book #1, page 174) indicates that the 1/4 corner position is mid-way between the section corners, and on a straight line. Length of line 17/16 is shown to be 5270 feet.

The notes in field book Black-67 indicates that a 3" Cedar post was set as the 1/4 post. 1935

1979 James H. Granger, P.S. 16041, Certificate of Survey in Section 16, Granger Engineering job SSU-1150-00. Survey identifies corner as a found 3/4" iron midway between section corners. Recorded in liber 470, page

Earl S. Strater, P.S. 28424, Certificate of Survey in Section 16, Chippewa job 85-334S. Survey identifies 1986 corner as 1/2" iron with 28424 cap. Recorded Liber 741, page 577.

William L. Karr, P.S. 27450, Northwoods Land Surveying job 178-10. Survey shows corner and witnesses as 1988 same recorded in Liber 471, page 577.

Recovered corner recorded by Strater. Position falls 3 feet East and midway between Section corners. 1996 Subsequent to road re-construction replaced comer with a 1/2" iron with cap no. 27450 in monument box.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: 1/4 Corner between Sections 16 and 17, Township 47 North, Range 1 East. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of original corner. Found a 1/2" iron with cap no. 27450 in monument box in the centerline of Shunk Road. Distance North to Section corner is 0.2 feet greater than distance South to Section corner. Accepted corner position as set by Strater.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: 1/4 Corner between Sections 16 and 17, Township 47 North, Range 1 East. Corner is a 1/2" iron with cap no. 27450 in a monument box in the centerline of Shunk Road.
