

I, William L. Karr, in a field survey on December 14, 1999, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1/4 Corner common to Sections 15 and 16, Township 47 North, Range 1 East.

James J. Mullett set post.

F.H. Brown, County Surveyor. Re-survey of County Farm, field notes filed in County Surveyor's office Green 1889 Field book #7. Brown's field notes (Green field book #7), dissertation, and map of County Farm survey can be found in the County Surveyor's office. Brown indicates there is a discrepancy between his 1/4 post and that of Carletons by 193 links. Brown's survey establishes the 1/4 post 40 chains North of the Section corner and on line from the Section corner to the meander corner. Brown then measures the distance from the 1/4 post West to the East line of the Methodist Mission Reserve as 17.1 chains (1128.6 feet).

L.E. Levin survey for M.N.P. Co. parcel 165 in Book 3 of Plats, County Surveyor's office in the location sketch 1963 for drawing. Levin identifies the 1/4 corner as an iron 40 chains North of Section corner and 11.7 chains South

of meander corner. Section line is shown East of Gardenville Road.

Neree D. Alix, P.E. survey sketch for E.L. Harvey (Job No.: 73070-s) field under T47N R1E Northwoods flat files. Note #2 on this drawing states "The West line of Section 15 is located 127 feet more or less East of the centerline of Ridge Road (See Court case of Chippewa County versus Sophia Pullar).

Earl S. Strater P.S. 28424 filed a LCRC in Liber 6, page 315. Strater set 1/2" iron with cap 40 chains from 1986

section corner approximately 2 feet West of the centerline of the Gardenville Road.

William L. Karr, P.S. 27450, Hellow Estates filed in Liber 15, page 24 of Plats. Plat show corner as fron set by Strater.

Lawrence E. Weinreis, P.S. 32343 filed a LCRC in Liber 8, page 275 in Chippewa County 1994

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (G-6) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 15 and 16, Township 47 North, Range 1 East. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of the original corner. Found 1/2" iron with cap no. 32343, two feet West of centerline of Gardenville Road. Distance South to Section corner is 2639.99. Distance West to East line of Methodist Mission Reserve is 987.9 feet.

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C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G-6) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 15 and 16, Township 47 North, Range 1 East.

Corner is a 3/4" iron with stamped 4" aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation Cap in monument box. Falls 2.0 feet West of centerline of Gardenville Road.

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B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (G-6) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 15 and 16. Township 47 North, Range 1 East.

Brown also stated that his Section line fell on an old road bed "plainly visible". There is no road bed visible East of the Gardenville Road, which may now be on the Brown line. In addition, the Section corner to the South is consistent with the other corners of the Pullar Farm survey. To attempt to move this corner East would serve no purpose, especially since there are many surveys based on its current position. Accepted corner position as found and replaced 1/2" iron with a 3/4" x 24" iron with stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap and placed in a monument box.
