

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron L.S. 27450 in a monument box. Corner has been used in many surveys. Originally re-established on the same line as the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  and Northeast Corner of Section 4 at record GLO distance from the Northeast corner of Section 4 in previous survey. Accepted corner position as found.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Corner is a 1" iron L.S. 27450 in a monument box, 1' South of the centerline of Six Mile Road and 15' West of the centerline of a railroad bridge.
