Found a 1/2" x 24" rebar along with 2 spruce and corner fence post witnesses as called for in above mentioned LCRC. Corner falls on the north edge of an east-west gravel road, which appears to have been built up considerably since 1985. Iron checks well with existing witnesses and also with other found corners in Section 22, which are shown in a section subdivision sketch by Fletcher.
