

I, William L. Karr, in a field survey on December 16, 1999, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: (K-5) Section Corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T. 47 N., R.

1845 James H. Mullett set post in original survey.

1908-1930 Various notes and sketches in the County Surveyors Office identify the corner and show measurements from it, but offer no description of monument or accessories.

F.H. Brown surveyed Plat of Garden Sub, recorded L. 4, P. 5 Chippewa County Plats. The section corner is the Northeast corner of the plat and was monumented with a 3/4" x 30" iron bolt.

J.P. Smallwood with the Michigan State Highway Department recovered a 3/4" iron and post at the corner and 1960 recorded it in L. 4, P. 5, Chippewa County Corner Records.

Thomas M. Kelly, P.S. 24599, recorded corner in L. 1, P. 348, Chippewa County Corner Records. Kelly 1978 describes the corner as a 1" drift pin found at record distances as described in highway notes.

Larry R. Rogers, P.S. 29251, certificate of survey in section 11 shows corner as found 1" drift pin with recard 1995 ties.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (K-5) Section Corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T. 47 N., R. 1 W.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Recovered the corner as recorded by Smallwood and Kelly. Available evidence indicates that this is the same corner as that used by Brown for Garden Sub and earlier county surveyor work. Accepted the corner position as found and replaced with a 3/4" x 48" iron with a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: (K-5) Section Corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T. 47 N., R. 1 W.

Corner is a 3/4" x 48" iron with stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap. The corner falls 20' West of an old North-South two track and on a brush line to the East.
