

5. Private Claims

I, William L. Karr, in a field survey on December 13, 1999, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: (L-5) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 12 and 13, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

1845 James H. Mullett set post in original survey.

1887 Guy H. Carleton surveyed Elmwood Park Addition, a subdivision of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of section 13. Carleton shows the "40" to be 1320' on a side and does not indicate what is at the 1/4 corner.

Guy H. Carleton surveyed Lake View Second Addition, a subdivision of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of section 12. Carleton shows the South line of the "40" as measuring 1312.5' and again does not mention a monument for the 1/4 corner.

Early 1900's Various sketches and notes in the County Surveyors Office show the 1/4 miles on the section line between 12 and 13 as measuring either 1306' or 1318'. None of the notes make mention of the 1/4 corner

1987 William L. Karr, P.S. 27450, survey of the Sault Ste. Marie airport property shows the 1/4 corner as a concrete monument set mid-way and on line between the section corners to the East and West.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (L-5) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 12 and 13, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner or of subsequent restoration. The two plats surveyed by Carleton in 1887 appear to have only been done on paper and were never monumented or developed. Could not find the concrete monument shown on the 1987 Airport Survey and a thorough search of available public records revealed no other indication of the corner being monumented.

Re-established the 1/4 corner mid-way and on line between the section corners to the East and West, consistent with the 1987 survey.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: (L-5) 1/4 Corner Between Sections 12 and 13, T. 47 N., R. 1 E.

Corner is a 3/4" x 48" iron with a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap. Corner falls on top of a ridge between 2 beaver ponds.
