A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: (F-3) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 47 North Range 2 East.

A 6" Spruce was marked as the original corner by John Mullett in 1845 and no bearing trees were recorder POVOMEN TO THE PROPERTY OF THE original field notes. We found no mention of this corner in the County Surveyor notes.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (F-3) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 47 North Range 2 East. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

No evidence of the original corner was recovered. Re-established the corner position midway and on-line between the Southeast and Southwest corners of Section 4. Distances to Section corners to East and West measure 2644.7 feet (G.L.O. 2643.3). The stream referenced in the original field notes in now a substantial beaver flooding. No stream bed was found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: (F-3) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 47 North Range 2 East.

Corner is a 3/4" x 48" rebar with stamped aluminum remonumentation cap on the East edge of a small peninsula that extends southwesterly into a beaver pond.
