

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C-1) Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 47 North, Range 2 East.

The original corner was placed in 1852 by John Mullett. Subsequent County Surveyor notes indicate a cedar post and cement post at corner. In 1991, William L. Karr, P.S. 27450 found a wood post and 1" iron pin in road intersection. Did not find cement post in the support of the 1" iron pin and recorded a L.C.R.C. in Liber 9, Page 133 of the Chippewa County Records. MARK WA CO

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

OVUMENT (C-1) Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 47 North, Range 2 East.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found 1" iron pin used by Karr. Corner is 4" below grade, on the centerline of Brassar Road (N-S, gravel), on the centerline of gravel road to West and 15 feet South of centerline of gravel road to Section 15 feet South of centerline 15 feet South o to West and 15 feet South of centerline of gravel road to East. Found three "Karr" witnesses intact. Accepted corner position as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: (C-1) Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 47 North, Range 2 East.

Corner is a 1" iron pin next to old wood post 4" below grade of gravel road intersection.
