A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

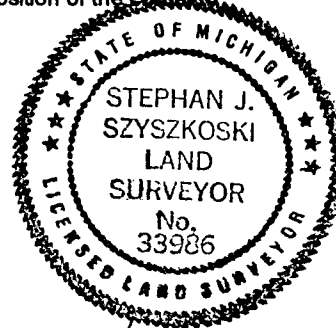
(G11) Corner common to Sections 27-28-33-34. 1959 - Remonumented from the stumps of the original Y.Pine BTs by Billy D. Buckler RLS. Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. 9" J.Pine N22W 20 links, 9" J.Pine S72E 23 links, 9" J.Pine S32W 29 links.
 (G12) Quarter corner common to Sections 33 and 34. 1959 - Corner remonumented by Billy D. Buckler RLS at the position of an old wood post and Spruce Pine OBT S41E 23 links. Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. 8" J.Pine N37E 14.5 links, 8" J.Pine S46E 16 links, 6" J.Pine N74W 15 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G11) Recovered the 1959 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1959 witness trees: the J.Pine NW in good condition, the J.Pine SE standing dead, and the J.Pine SW a cut stump. No evidence remains of the original Y.Pine BTs. Left the monument in place and made new witnesses as described below.
 (G12) Recovered the 1959 monument in good condition but without the brass cap, at record bearing and distance from the 1959 witnesses: The J.Pines SE and NW are in good condition, the J.Pine NE is dead. Left the monument in place and made new witnesses. Installed a new alum. cap on the monument.
