All Standard Corners on the South line of T19N, R3W, were established in 1838. In 1856 the Closing Corners for T18N, R3W were recovered in a GLO resurvey. The MSHD survey notes of 1933 state that the corners used in that survey are the T18N, R3W Closing Corners. The MSHD right-of-way maps indicate that the Standard and Closing Corners are common (which they are not). All evidence of the original corners has been destroyed in highway construction. The preserved monumented corners have been used as both T19N & T18N, R3W, common corners in most subsequent surveys. Although not conclusive, farm fence lines south of this line tend to support the monuments as Closing Corners. The 1856 resurvey of T18N, R3W, states that along with A
