

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner.

- '¼ Corner common to Sec. 33 & 34 Fd. Bent 5/8" iron rebar at Gravel Road surface Remon. Cap gone. Straighten and drove down rebar. CL. of N-S Gravel Rd. is 2' E. South 235' (230' GLO S. bank stream 10 L. ESE) to CL. culvert for stream E. Measured grid distances as follows: N0°08'36"E 2658.62' vs. 2670.69' GLO, 2685.3' ADJ, 2655.53' MM, 2658.10' CEO to "G11" and S0°44'42"E 2650.32' vs. 2664.09' GLO, 2647.26' ADJ, 2655.53' MM, 2651.5' CEO to "G13". Fd. Conc. Mon. at NW cor. of Lot 1 of "Popple Creek" at S0°44'42"E 596.02' and N89°15' 18" E 34.48' (33'-P) of "G12". Measured angle of 90°58'53" vs. 90°56'20" Plat from "G12" to "G13" to "H13". Thus it is apparent that McClung's position is approx'ly 2' E and 4' N of the Remon. position. Per discussion with Clare Co. Surveyor Paul B. Lapham, Paul indicated he thought the Remon. position at Ostling's position should remain as is, since the plat would stand on its own. Thus accepted Remon. 5/8" rebar as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
