

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

E12 - 1/4 Corner common to Sec. 32 & 33, T20N, R3W - Fd. 1/2" capped iron #17614 per Cavanagh LCRC. LCRC by Robison in error-apparently description for "G12". Hub and fence line noted by Cavanagh is gone. Measured grid distance South to "E13" of 2676.85' vs. 2664.09'-GLO, 2672.341 - CSR, 2677.62' - LLC. Checked GLO topo calls from "E12" as follows: South 137' (85'-GLO) to S. Bank Stream - At this location is breached beaver dam and channel location could have moved; South 165'± 30' (156'-GLO) of Edge of swamp; North 700'± 50' (636'-GLO) edge of swamp - wide transition. Based on above observations the 1/2" CIR is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
