

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

<u>D11</u> – ½ Corner common to Sec. 29 & 32 – Fd. ¾ I.D. iron pipe w/ bent 1" guard pipe on SE side. Fits witnesses by Courtright and Lapham. Fd. remains of both Pine BT's noted by the Co. survey record; the N 80°E Pine Stp. noted as being the GLO BT. Measured as follow N81°E 32.4' to CL remains WPS and North 45'± to remains of PS on E. side Large Oak (BT). Anchor post or brace post for barb wire W & S is 7' West. ¾" Iron pipe accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

2. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

21.1 – Drove stamped 2" Alum. Cap on 5/8" x 17" iron rebar into center of Fd. ¾" iron pipe.
