

 Found ½" CIR #27458 – S88°15'E 3.46' of set 2" AC.
 M. Robison had established this position based on DNR working drawing position 'D5' that was not accepted by Remon. Peer review group. C 1/2 corner section 17 – set 2" aluminum cap on 5/8" X 34" rebar at intersection of quarter lines per standard BLM
- N 1/16 corner common to sec 16 & 17 found ½" X 24" iron rebar per Henning, 0.08'N & 0.51' E of Calc. position. Also found ½" CIR # 9433 0.14' W & 0.46' S of calc. position. Accepted Hennings' ½" iron as the best available evidence of the corner since it was placed first and Lapham's position is based on Henning position at 'E5' & 'E6'
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
