VanRaemdonck, in a field survey on, June 10, 1999, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - 1. Original, Hervey Parke, D.S., January 1827.

Monument: Wood post

4. Maurice H. Mahieu, Certified Survey, recorded Liber 815, page 679, November 2, 1998. Monument: 1/2" bar in monument box.

Mag N&T S. side util. pole N66°E 81.54'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

Found 1/2" diameter rerod in monument box as referenced in No. 3 and No. 4 above. Measured 5275.09 feet between corners A-13 and A-11, T5N-R2W. Measured 2633.60 feet between A-11 and A-10, T5N-R2W, (Hollister's distance here was 39.92 chains or 2634.72 feet). Found no conflicting evidence and accepted this location as the original corner position based on the best available evidence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a standard Clinton County Remonumentation monument, being a 2 1/2" diameter steel tube, 30" long with a standard brass cap, stamped "P.S. 24622", and a breakaway magnetic base at the corner location described in Section B above. The monument is witnessed by the following accessories:

S65°W 66.89' Fnd. N&T N. face util. Pole N65°E 81.60' Fnd. N&T S. face util. Pole N00°10'09"W 10.56' Remon Monument at M-11 N45°W 46.44' Fnd. N&T SW face util. Pole N75°E 48.79' W. face north gate post S00°10'09"E 2630.63' Remon Monument at M-12
