Found 1" pipe in monument box 10' North of centerline of road, as called for in LCRC by Richard Steadman, PS. Accepted 1" pipe in monument box as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

Removed pipe and monument box. Set Standard Clinton County Monument and monument box.

Eddy's survey also notes stones ¼ mile, 3/8 mile, and ½ mile to the West of this corner. Dug holes in Eaton Hwy. In search of these four stones. The only ones found were those ¼ mile and 3/8 mile West of the subject corner. Determined the position for this corner by projecting the line of the found stones East a distance equal to twice the distance between them. The corner located in this manner falls about 8 feet North of the center of the road. Set a 1" iron to mark the corner. Witnesses:
