I, Mark L. VanRaemdonck, in a field survey on June 9, 1999, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law: established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - 1. Original, Lucius Lyon, D.S. 1826. Monument: Wood Post. Accessories: Beech 9 S29°W 13 Do 9 N28°W 14
  - 2. Black Leather Notebook, 7 1/2" x 9 1/2", on file in Clinton County Drain Office, surveyor and date unknown. Monument: Not given. Accessories: Sugar 6 N57°E 62
  - 3. Duane A. Ankrom, Consumer's Power Company survey, recorded Liber 1, page 913, June 22, 1977. Monument: Not given. (Corner location shown but not monumented)
    Accessories: N00°32'46"W 2612.52 feet to set rerod & cap at corner M-1. S00°32'46"E 2636.24 feet to found 5/8" reord in monument box at corner M-3.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

Found rerod and cap as referenced in No. 4 above. Found a 1/2" diameter rerod N13°W 12.01 feet being the West 1/4 of Section 6, (A-2), T5N-R2W, Ankrom's distance to M-1 is 4.7 feet long from ours and his distance to M-3 is 4.41 feet short. His total distance from M-1 to M03 is 0.29 feet long from ours (5248.76 - 5248.47 = 0.29). Ankrom's position is a calculated position based on proportional distances to the G.L.O. distances. Our measurement to M-3 (2648.65 feet) is in close accord to Bryan's (2648.53 feet). I accepted the Bryan position as the original corner position based on the best available evidence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a Standard Clinton County Remonumentation Monument, being a 2 ½" diameter steel tube, 30" long with a standard brass cap, stamped "P.S. 24622" and a breakaway magnetic base at the corner location described in Section B above. Found no conflicting evidence. The monument is witnessed by the following accessories:
