

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

Found no other record of subsequent restoration. Re-established this corner position using the single proportion method between corners M-5 and M-7. Used corner A-6, T5N-R2W, for control East and West. Found no conflicting evidence and accepted this location as the careful and faithful re-establishment of the original corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a standard Clinton County Remonumentation monument, being a 2 ½" diameter steel tube, 30" long with a standard brass cap, stamped "P.S." 24622" and a breakaway magnetic base at the corner location described in Section B above. The monument is witnessed by the following accessories:
