

We were unable to locate the monument described in No. 4 and 5 above due to recent paving of Alward Road. Crossed references in No. 4 and 5 above to determine corner location. This location fits the witness by Hollister in No. 2 above that being: Burr Oak 6 N66½E 188. Excavation for standard monument revealed no further evidence accepted this position as the original corner location based on the best available evidence.
