B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Extended the line between M-2 and M-3 South 2634.27 feet (Hollister's distance = 2634.06 feet). This follows Hollister's survey of 1902 when he ran a line between M-1 and M-4 to re-establish M-3. This location is proportional to Hollister's distance to M-5 (Hollister's distance = 2627.46 feet, our distance = 2627.67 feet). This location is also supported by monumentation found in the plat of Highland Hills. Found 1/2" rerod in centerline of asphalt surface 5.68 feet East and 3.3 feet North of this location. This rerod was found as referenced in no. 5 and no. 6 above and was not established using proper procedures. Found a 5"x5"x8" stoned during excavation for standard monument and monument box. Accepted this location as the original corner position based on the best available evidence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
