8. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Set standard Clinton County Monument at single proportion between M-11 and M-13. Found no evidence of Hollister's position. Found no fences or corner posts. This position is approximately 66 feet North of the centerline of the Maple River which agrees with G.L.O. topo call. Found no conflicting evidence. Accepted this position as the careful and faithful re-establishment of the corner position.
