A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

GLO Notes, survey by Lucius Lyon, D.S., in 1827. Set Half Mile Post 10" Sugar - S48°E - 21 links; 9" Beech - S83°W - 16 links.

County Surveyor Notes by R. H. Colburn, County Surveyor, in 1886. Found old stump Red Oak (18" when taken) now 36". Proved at point and set stone, R. Oak stump 36" - N52°W - 52 links.

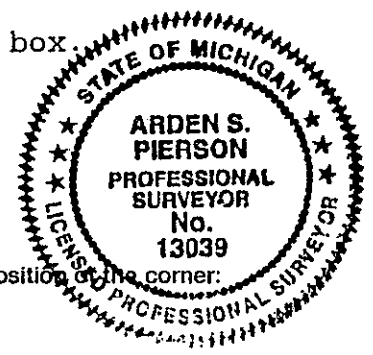

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found RR spike 4.8' west of road centerline and in line with fence east, verified 1975 witnesses by Clinton County Road Commission. Accepted RR spike as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

1/4 Corner Common to Sections 20 & 21

- *Standard Clinton County Monument in monument box
- Face Top 2" Diameter Metal Anchor Post - N87°W - 27.55'
- Nail & tag #13039 in NW Side 10" Elm - S42°W - 45.62'
- Nail & tag #13039 in S. Side Wood Anchor Post - N90°E - 37.93'
- Nail & tag #13039 in SE Side Power Pole - N43°E - 171.27'

*Standard Clinton County Monument is a 2 1/2" dia. steel tube 30" long with a stamped brass cap and a breakaway magnetic base.
