Norman C. Caldwell , in a field survey on April do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned In lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Α
- Twp. Cor. common to Sec. 1, TEN-RIW and Sec. 36, T7N-RIW M-01

Township Corner post established February 25, 1824 by Joseph Wampler, D.S. N 42 1/2 W 24 lks (15.84') 8" W. Oak 8 34 N 64 lks (42.24') 13" Oak

- C. E. Hollister, County Surveyor, Book #2, Page 65, dated 28 December 1891, found a stone and one U.S. bearing tree. References 8 78 W 42 lks (27.72') 5" Cherry, N 17 1/2 W 141 lks (93.06') 18" W. Oak. Ran north from this point to corner M-11 (no distance given)
- C. E. Hollister, County Surveyor, Book #5, Page 21, dated 21 April 1902, used this position in survey of North & East lines of Section 1, T6N-RIW. (No new references marked)
- C. E. Hollister, County Surveyor, Book #5, Page 24; no date, used this position and ran North to H-12, T7N-R1W, 40.09 chs, and set stone for 1/16th Corner @ midpoint. (SEE SECTION "A" CONTINUED ON BACK)
- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: В.
- Twp. Cor. common to Sec. 1, T6N-R1W and Sec. 36, T7N-R1W M-01

The position for this monument falls in a 3 to 4' road cut and there is no apparent evidence of the original post or Hollister monument.

In the performance of retracement of the Michigan Meridian along the Easterly boundary of T7N-RIW, this position was tied into the control network and observed to be significantly out of position with the recovered and reliable monumentation. Upon investigation of field notes and office computations performed by staff of Rowe Engineering, Inc., an error in calculations and use of the Closing Township Corner which by-passed the standard E 1/4 Corner of Section 36 was discovered, which led to further investigation.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Twp. Cor. common to Sec. 1, T6N-R1W and Sec. 36, T7N-R1W

Placed a Standard Clinton County monument, consisting of a 2" x 30" steel pipe, 3-1/4" brass cap, and plastic base with magnet in a monument box in the centerline of existing pavement, in line with an ancient fence West, in accord with the "calls" of the Alden Creek Drain Extension records and the recovered monumentation of subsequent surveys by Hollister and E.S.
