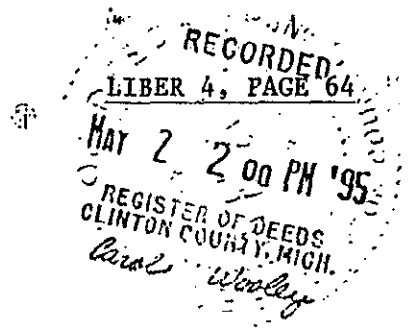

No county surveyor records.

Subsequent recordation of this corner by Mark VanRaemdonck recorded in L.2, P.733 dated 6/22/90 stating he found a RR Spik at centerline - centerline with the following witnesses;

Found RR Spike 0.80' below gravel surface
