Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

D. W. Aetenburg, Deputy Gratiot County Surveyor, in a survey made June 6 and 27-29, 1870 and recorded in Book "A" at page 184 and Book "B" at page 70 indicates this corner position is marked by a post under a stone. He marked the following references: N 77 N 1.2025 Ch (79.36') 60" Cak and S 21 N .6575 under a stone. He mark Ch (43.40') 6" Hickory.

Ransom J. Fraker, Gratiot County Surveyor, in a survey made April 24-26, 1877, and recorded in Book "B" at page 243 repeats the previous record by D. W. Λ .

Survey of Section 6, T 8 N, R 1 W, by H. H. Jenison, Clinton County Surveyor, on the 10, 11 & 12th of June, 1876, recorded in the Clinton County Surveyors Record, Volume #1 at page 30, indicates dimensions to this position but does not recite new references.

Found record 3/4" pipe (6" deep) over a 3/4" pipe (42" deep) with stones, brick & crockery. There is no apparent conflicting evidence and this position is accepted as a perpetuation of the original government corner

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Standard Township Cor. of T8 & 9N, R1 & 2W

Survey of Section 1, T 8 N. R 2 W, by Charles E. Hollister, Clinton County Surveyor, on the 13, 14 & 15th of May, 1879, recorded in the Clinton County Surveyors record, Volume #1, at page 74, indicates a stone at this position with one witness stump standing. He marked the following new reference: S 13 E 42.25 links (27.89') 6" Burr Oak

David B. Whittier, P.S. #10070, in surveys dated August 12, 1974 recorded in Liber 1 at page 349 and an L.C.R.C. dated August, 1974 recorded in Liber 1 at page 269, found large stone with crockery & china around, also 7 small stones and placed a 3/4" pipe. He marked the following references: S 45 B 41.00' 18" Maple and S 70 E 88.68 50" Oak

John F. Quine, P.S. #10070, in a survey dated 5 April 1977 and recorded in Liber 1 at page 875, found a 3/4" Pipe, 6" deep at this position and marked new references H 45 E 38.95' Telephone riser, S 45 E 35.75' Road sign, S 45 E 40.95' 16" Haple, S 45 W 35.75' Telephone riser, S 55 W 45.9' 24" Stump, H 45 W 32.7' Road sign.

Mark L. Vanraemdonck, P.S. 24622, on a survey dated 25 March, 1986 in Liber 2 at page 911 and an L.C.R.C. dated 22 August 1985 in Liber 2 at page 582 found record 3/4" pipe and recorded the following references: 8 30 E 35.82' NW Cor. road sign post, N 45 E 39.00' bolt in top of telephone riser, N 45 W 32.68' SE face road sign post, S 45 W 37.00' top center tel. cable pedestal.
