- C11 Section corner common to Sec. 29, 30, 31 & 32 Fd. ½" x 2.5" iron rod in 4" x 24" red clay tile filled with concrete per Houghton in 1923 and used by Ostling's, Henning and Kiiskila.Top 6" of tile was broken. CL. of NN'E Bit. rd. is ESE 69'. Tile Mon. is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

 C11 Replaced Tile Mon. w/ 2 1/2" x 21" Crawford Co. cast iron breakaway Harrison monument. Placed broken clay tile around the base and broken concrete around the top of the monument as memorials.
