- M-5 [NE COR SEC 13] FOUND 3/4" I.P. AND ROTTED REMAINS OF WOOD POST FROM WHICH A PINE STUMP BEARS N56°E-45'- ACCEPTED EXISTING MONUMENT AS BEING A CAREFUL & FAITHFUL REESTABLISHMENT OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.
- L-3 [N1/4 COR SEC 12] IN 1970 I FOUND A 1-1/4" I.P. FROM WHICH A JACK PINE STUMP BEARS NORTH 109.9°, SCRIBE MARKS STILL PLAIN, ACCEPTED SAME AS BEING THE MONUMENT SET BY MCRABB IN 1932 AND NOTED NEW BT'S AT THAT TIME. THIS DATE I FOUND THE 1-1/4" I.P. IN PLACE ALL BT'S NOTED IN 1970 HAVE BEEN DESTROYED OR REMOVED BY CONSTRUCTION OF A ROADWAY TO THE NORTH.
