

- C-6 East 1/4 corner of Section 18. Wood post. W. Birch 10 S40W 22 1ks. W. Birch 10 - N45E - 19 1ks.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
  - B-7 Set from stump remains of the northeast 0.B.T. (12" cedar-N30°E-5 1ks.) Callous around bottom blaze plain but face badly burned, no scribe marks visible. Mea. to stream 396 ft. west fits G.L.O. record very well.
  - C-7 Set by double proportion to the G.L.O. record using sec. cors. 1 mile north and 1 mile east and 1/4 cors. 1/2 mile south and 1/2 mile west.
  - C-6 Set M.P.O.L. between the NE and the SE section cors. of Section 18.
