1890 - Cira - C&NW plans shows corner 486 fet north of R.R. centerline.

WEPCO section diagram indicates pipe at corner position lying south of old R.R. grade (no date).

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1" pipe 35.5 feet south of old R.R. grade, as per WEPCO plans. Cut lines are running north, south and east with a traverse line running northeasterly. The corner checks with the 486 feet north of the existing C&NW R.R. The corner position has been used and accepted by several surveyors and has been used in many surveys. I am accepting the one inch pipe as marking the true corner locations.
