B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found H.L. Wagner's post rotted and laying in swamp with the post point in the hole. Found Wagner's ash B.T. now a 9" and his poplar now a 17". Both check well with his distances to the post point. The post lies 12 feet± north of Spring Brook, GLO is 13.2 feet. I am accepting Wagner's post as marking the true corner position.
