Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

September 21, 1993 - I found a 4" sq. concrete monument. Blazed line extends west and east from this corner. I found an existing bearing tree with scribing at S81°W, 21.85 feet. A local resident, Mr. McBroom, took us to this corner and claimed that the concrete post has been accepted as the 1/4 corner as long as he can recall. Accepted this as the corner position after checking distances to other known corners.
