I, John R. Garske, in a field survey on October 10, 1994, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1847 - Original survey by A. Brevoort. Set post. Original bearing trees: birch 16" - S65°W, 11 links; sugar 10" - N35°W, 32 links.

1941 - Dickinson Co. Rd. Commission survey shows corner to be existing.

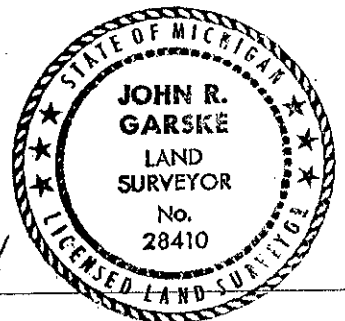
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a 1" O.D. iron pipe pointed out to us by a local resident who stated pipe has been there since 1951. It checks good with the GLO call of 1.8 chs. west to foot of hill. Accepted this pipe as the corner since it is in harmonious position and is generally accepted as the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced 1" O.D. pipe with Dickinson County aluminum monument. Established following references: carsonite rail - North, 1.35 feet; 8" basswood - N41°E, 47.86 feet; 8" sugar maple - S17°E, 58.96 feet; 9" ash - S66°W, 3.39 feet; 6" basswood - N40°W, 21.59 feet.
